

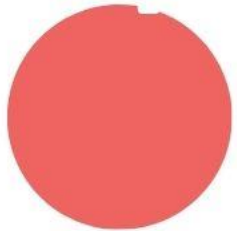

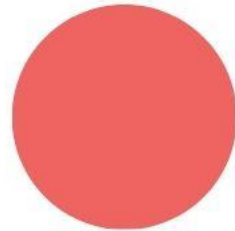
MISSION STATEMENT

We aim for Erdington Elim to be a place, where people feel welcome and loved. This is a place where everyone has the opportunity to:



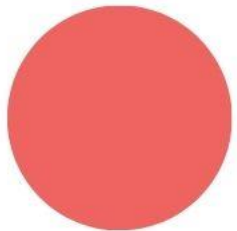
